

BENCHMARK PROJECT MANAGEMENT (UK) LTD CASE STUDY

Title:

Footpath at Tuffley Park, Gloucester.

General Scope:

The 'Friends of Tuffley Park' were successfully awarded Levelling Up Funding and required a 245-metre-long granular pedestrian pathway across the park.

Works included:

- Excavate 2.0m wide footpath to formation level.
- Install timber edging with timber pegs.
- Lay a Geo-textile membrane.
- Lay & compact 100mm thick of MOT Type 1 sub-base material.
- Lay & compact 50mm depth of Breedon Gravel (12mm to fines).
- Reinstate grass verge areas & re-seed.
- Removal of all spoils off site to license waste facility.
